STEPS TO BECOMING A CHRISTIAN

Step 1: Recognize your need.

1. We are all sinners by nature and by choice. (Romans 3:23)
3. We cannot save ourselves. (Ephesians 2:9)
4. We deserve death and hell. (Romans 6:23)

Step 2: Understand God's provision for your need.

1. Jesus is God and became man. (John 1:1, 14)
2. Jesus died for us on the cross. (1 Peter 3:18)
3. Jesus was resurrected from the dead. (Romans 4:25)

Step 3: Respond to God's provision for your need.

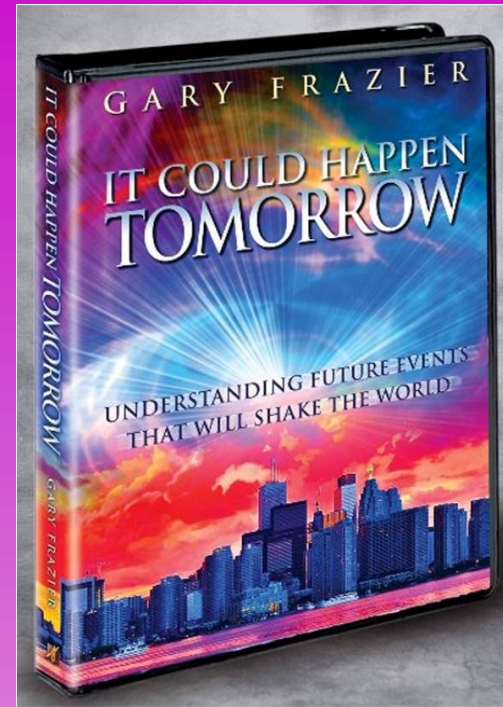
1. I must repent of my sin. (Acts 3:19)
 Repentance is turning to God through Jesus Christ.
2. I must place my faith in Jesus (Ephesians 2:8)
 - Faith is not just believing facts about Jesus.
 - Faith is trusting Jesus.
3. I must surrender to Jesus as Lord. (Romans 10:9-10) It means to give Jesus your life.

As evidence of giving Jesus control, you will want to identify with Him. The New Testament way is to confess Jesus publicly and to follow Him in baptism and church membership. Ask a staff member or deacon if you'd like to know more.

HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF TRINITY BAPTIST CHURCH

The pastor, a deacon or a staff member will be available to visit with you today at the end of the sermon, or this week by calling the church office at 601-636-8121 for an appointment. You may join our church in any of the following ways:

1. **By Committing Your Life to Jesus Christ.** If you are not yet a Christian, but are interested in becoming a Believer, we will gladly share with you how you may accept Christ. Upon your profession of faith and baptism you will be received as a member.
2. **By Baptism.** If you are already a Christian but have not been baptized by immersion after your commitment to Christ, you may request baptism. This will be scheduled at your convenience, and upon your baptism you will be received as a member.
3. **By Statement of Your Faith and Baptism.** If you have been saved by faith in Jesus Christ as personal savior and have subsequently been baptized by immersion in water, you may join by statement of your faith and prior baptism.
4. **By Transferring Your Membership.** If you are a member of another Baptist church, you may simply request to transfer your membership into our church. We will write a letter to your former church notifying them of your change in membership.

GA BULLETIN BOARD

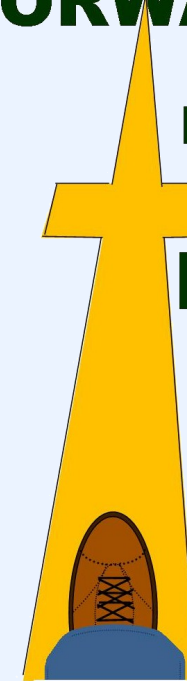
