Sunday School will begin at 9:30 a.m. with a high attendance goal of 135+! ## Annie Armstrong Easter Offering for North American Missions

**Why** do we give to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (AAEO)? To help our missionary force reach for Christ an estimated 259 million lost people in United States and Canada. That is three of four people.

**How much** of this offering is used to support missionaries and their work? 100%

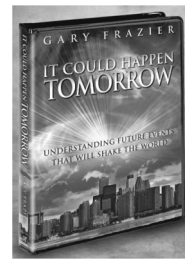
